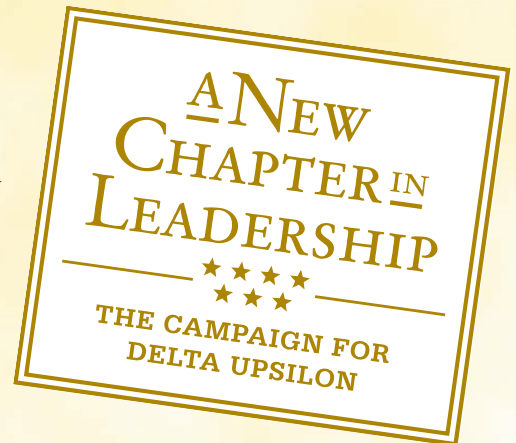
He now lives in Colorado and owns a manufacturer's rep agency which he has operated for 27 years.

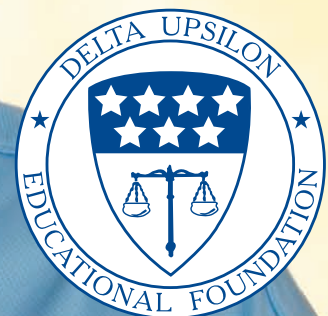
"They establish relationships that will help keep them in school and prepare them for their post-college careers as well as community involvement and family life.
